

In recent years having a DJ cover a wedding ceremony has become more and more popular. That's why I wrote this article. I truly hope it is helpful!

CEREMONIES with DJ:

- *Time Duration for DJ at a ceremony:*

Hire a DJ for a total of one hour:

- *At least 15 minutes before ceremony starts for prelude music and seating...plus*
- *30-45 minutes for actual ceremony (processional, vows, recessional...plus*
- *10-15 minutes for guests to exit ceremony area*

- *Cost of DJ covering ceremony (this depends on):*

- *Ease or difficulty of set up for DJ*
- *Exact location of ceremony (if the ceremony will take place within 75 feet or less of where the DJ sets up for the reception, that's an easy set up). Generally, outdoor wedding ceremonies need a 2nd or separate set up from the reception set up which costs more and takes the DJ more time to set up properly.*

- *Where the DJ should set up for the ceremony (the DJ should know best!) It depends on:*

- *A) where the bridal party will walk from*
- *B) location/area of archway (where officiant stands)*
- *C) where electric is located for DJ equipment*
- *D) distance of speakers to wireless microphone(s) (note: can't be too far for best transmission reception; this is very important because the mic clarity can go in and out)*
- *Pricing can range from: included in a package deal or between \$150-\$450+ depending on: a)equipment needed, b)venue requirements, c)duration, d)distance from reception area*
- *NOTE:* *If your venue has an end time limit (music off by 10:00 PM), then you'll want to start your ceremony accordingly. Remember too that if*
